Privacy Policy Last updated: July 30, 2023

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures for collecting, using, and disclosing your information when you use the Service and informs you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation Words with capitalized initials have defined meanings under the following conditions. The following definitions have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or plural form.

Definitions For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

 Account means a unique account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service. Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interests, or other securities entitled to vote for the election of directors or other executive authorities. • Application refers to Cube Smash, the software program provided by the Company. • Company (referred to as "the Company," "We," "Us," or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Cube Smash. • Country refers to: Italy. • Device means any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, mobile phone, or digital tablet. • Personal Data refers to any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual. • Service refers to the Application. • Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, provide the Service on behalf of the Company, perform services related to the Service, or assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used. • Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, generated by the use of the Service or the Service infrastructure (e.g., the duration of a page visit). • User means the individual accessing or using the Service or the company, or another legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data During your use of our service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

• Usage data

Usage data

Usage Data is collected automatically when you use the Service.

Usage Data may include information such as your device's Internet protocol address (for example, IP address), browser type, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. Use of your personal data

- To manage your inquiries: To participate in and manage your inquiries to Us.
- For business transfers: We may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, assignment, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of a bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, where Personal Data held by us about users of our Service is among the transferred assets.
- For other purposes: We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and to evaluate and improve our service, products, services, marketing and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

- With service providers: We may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze usage of our service, to contact you.
- For corporate transfers: We may share or transfer your personal information in connection with, or in the negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- With affiliates: We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that we control or are under common control with us.
- With business partners: We may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products, services or promotions.
- With Other Users: When you share personal information or otherwise interact in public areas with other users, that information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed externally.
- With your consent: We may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.

Retention of your personal data

The Company will only keep your personal data for as long as necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of Our Service, or when We are legally required to retain this data for longer periods of time.

Transfer of your personal data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other place where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to - and held on - computers located outside your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your consent to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your personal data will take place to an organization or a country unless they are in put in place adequate controls, including the security of your data and other personal information.

Delete your personal data

You have the right to delete or request our assistance in deleting the personal data we have collected about you.

Our Service may give you the ability to delete certain information about yourself from within the Service.

You can update, change or delete your information at any time by logging into your account, if you have one, and visiting the account settings section which allows you to manage your personal information. You may also contact us to request access, correction or deletion of any personal information you have provided to us.

Please note, however, that we may need to keep certain information when we have a legal obligation or legal basis to do so.

Disclosure of your personal data

Business transaction
